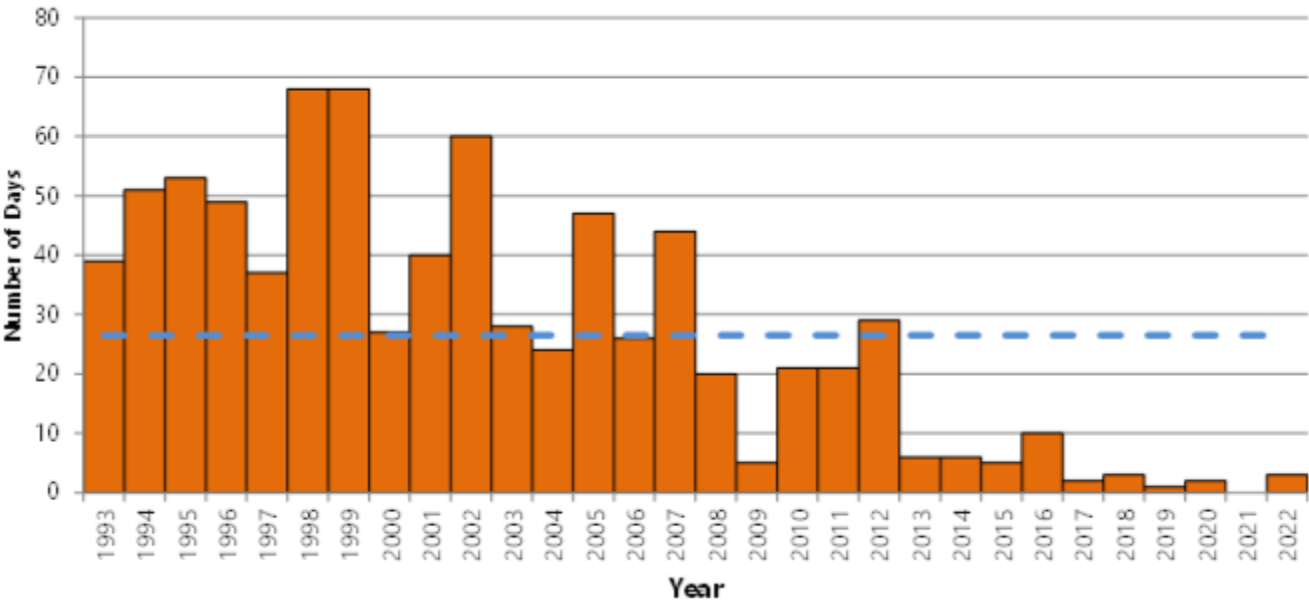

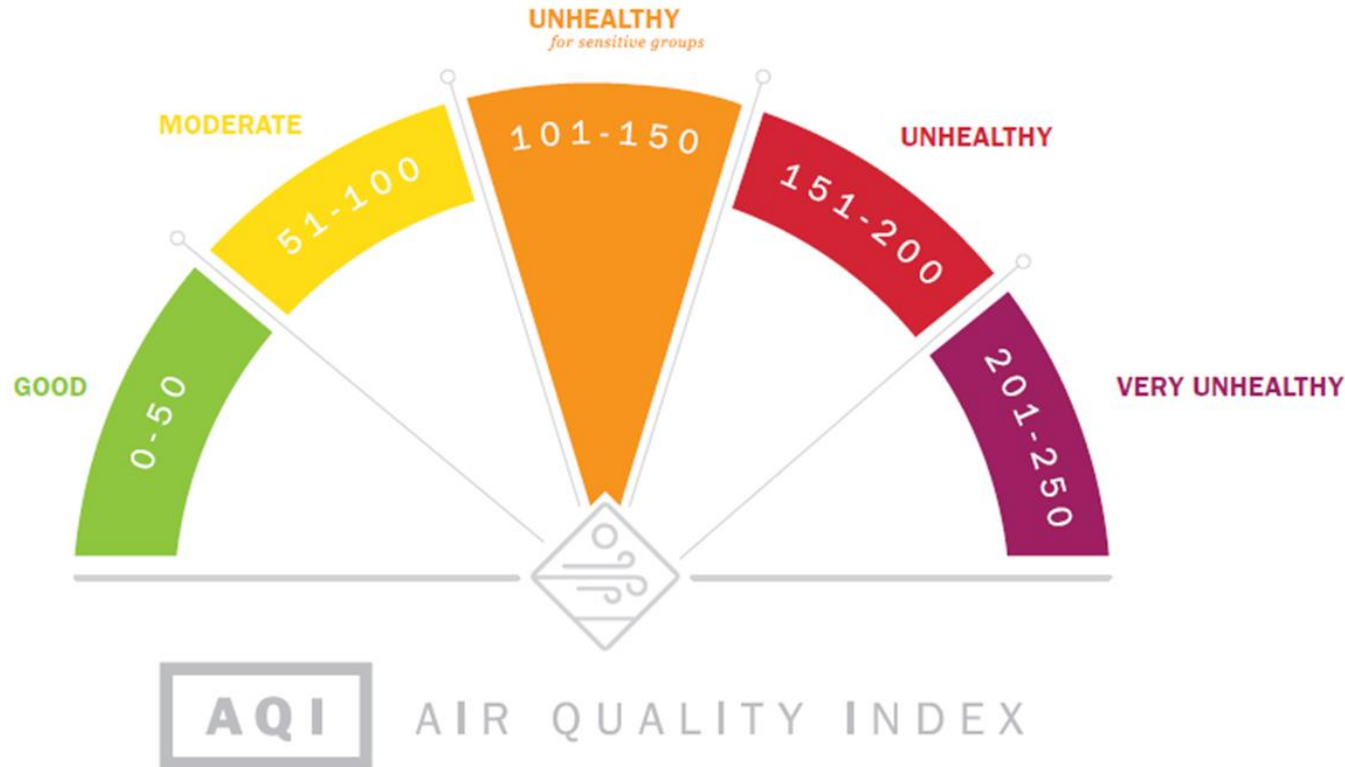

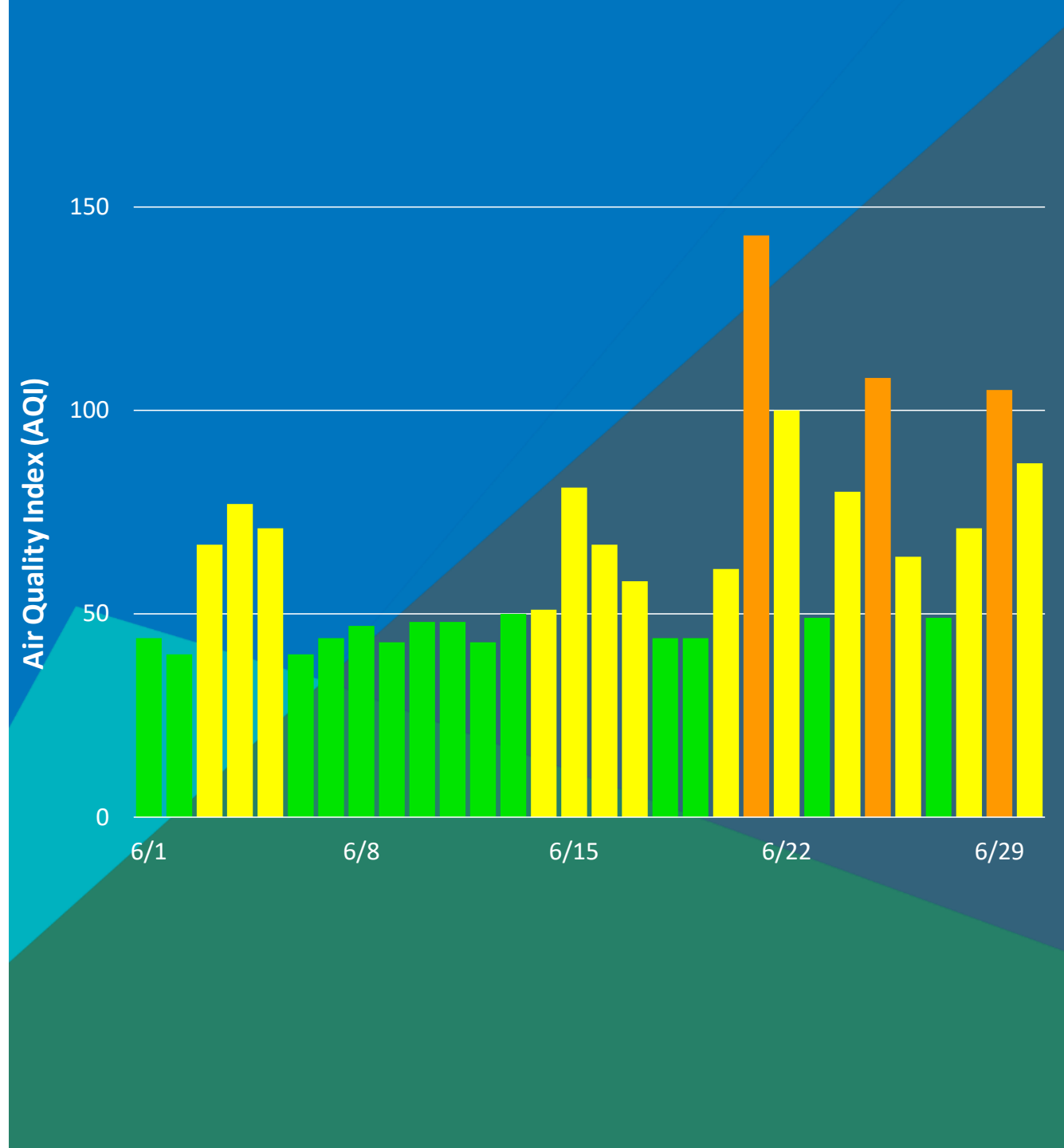

# JUNE 2022 RE-CAP

- AQI levels observed in June 2022
- First month MORPC issued an Air Quality Alert in nearly 2 years.
- The three (3) USG ozone days were the most recorded in the Columbus region in four years.
- Ozone precursors – high temps in mid-90's, wildfire smoke, and light winds

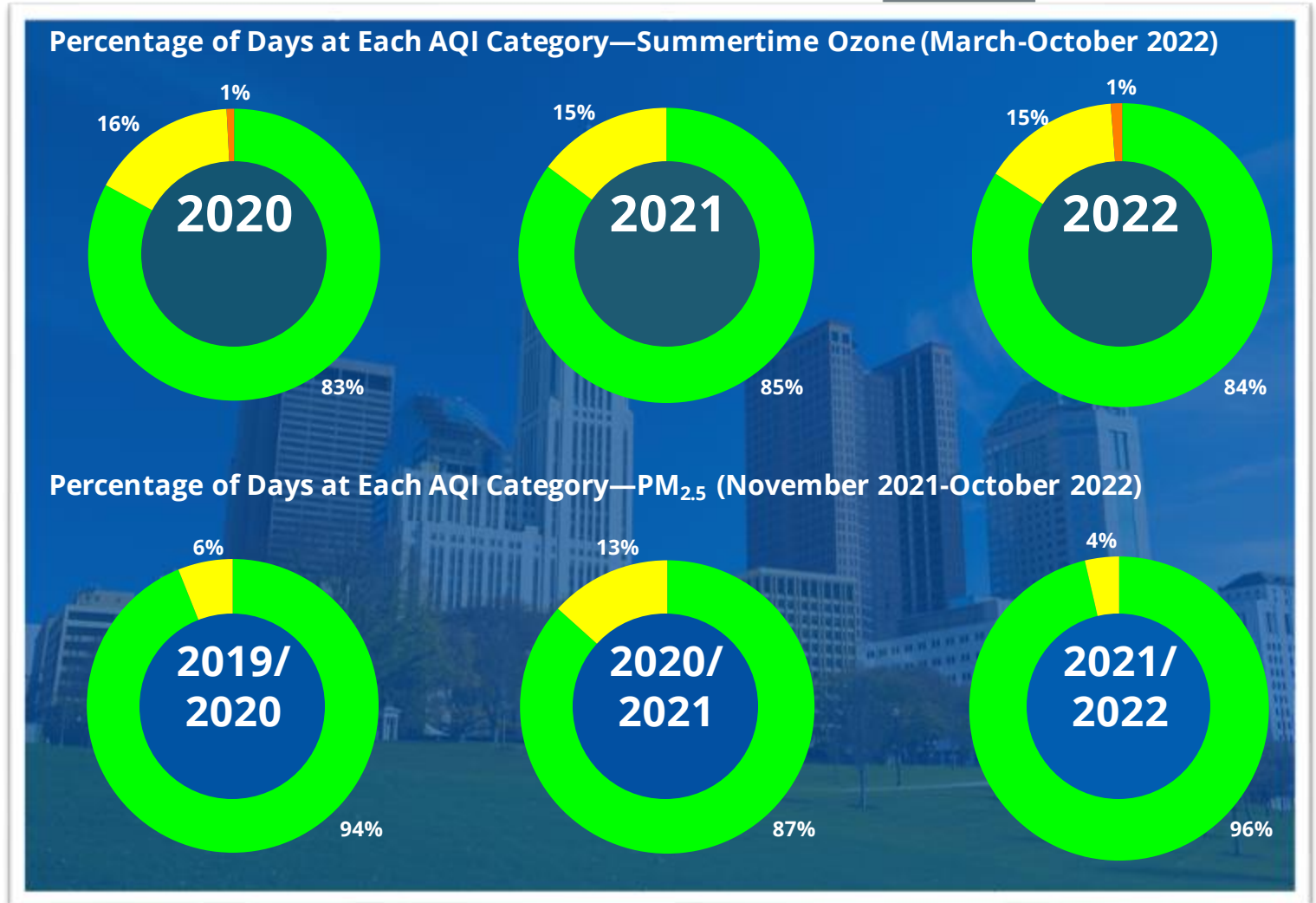


# Central Ohio End of Season Report | 2021-22

- Four (4) Air Quality Alerts
- For ozone, 84% of summer days were in the Good AQI category.
- For PM2.5, 96% of all days were in the Good AQI category.
- 12th consecutive season without USG PM2.5 levels
