

CENTRAL OHIO END OF SEASON REPORT 2021-22





JUNE 2022 RE-CAP

- AQI levels observed in June 2022
- First month MORPC issued an Air Quality Alert in nearly 2 years.
- The three (3) USG ozone days the most recorded in the Columbus region in four years.
- Ozone precursors high temps in mid-90's, wildfire smoke, and light winds






CENTRAL OHIO END OF SEASON REPORT 2021-22



- Ozone
 - 84% of summer days were in the Good AQI category.
- PM2.5 (particulate matter)
 - 96% of all days were in the Good AQI category.
 - 12th consecutive season without USG PM2.5 levels
 - Note: Federal PM2.5 standard under revision
