




#### **Vision Zero**

- 50% of the fatal crashes in Columbus involve a pedestrian, bicyclist, or motorcyclist






#### Vision Zero

- 150 new or upgraded crosswalks
- Distracted Driving Legislation in effect as of April 2023

  - City standards for bikeways and pedestrian facilities










