To complete your MBA, you will take classes for 5 semesters, spread over 3 calendar years. This helps you to maximize your employer's tuition benefits (when eligible), which you can combine with the corporate discount, making this MBA program extremely affordable at little to no out-of-pocket costs. You are also able to defer your tuition payment until the end of the semester when you receive your tuition reimbursement.
