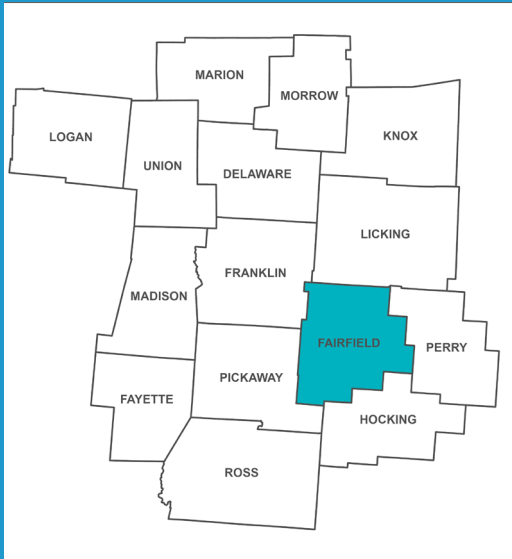


BASIL WESTERN ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

PROJECT
PROFILE

The Basil Western Road Improvements project aims to update traffic infrastructure to Hill Road, Kings Crossing, and Basil Western Road. The project includes the reconstruction of approximately 1,400 feet of Basil-Western Road, with widening for turn lanes and associated tapers, and supports the potential development for 1.7 million square feet of warehouse and industrial space.
